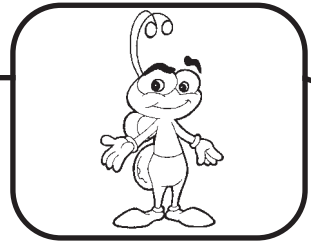


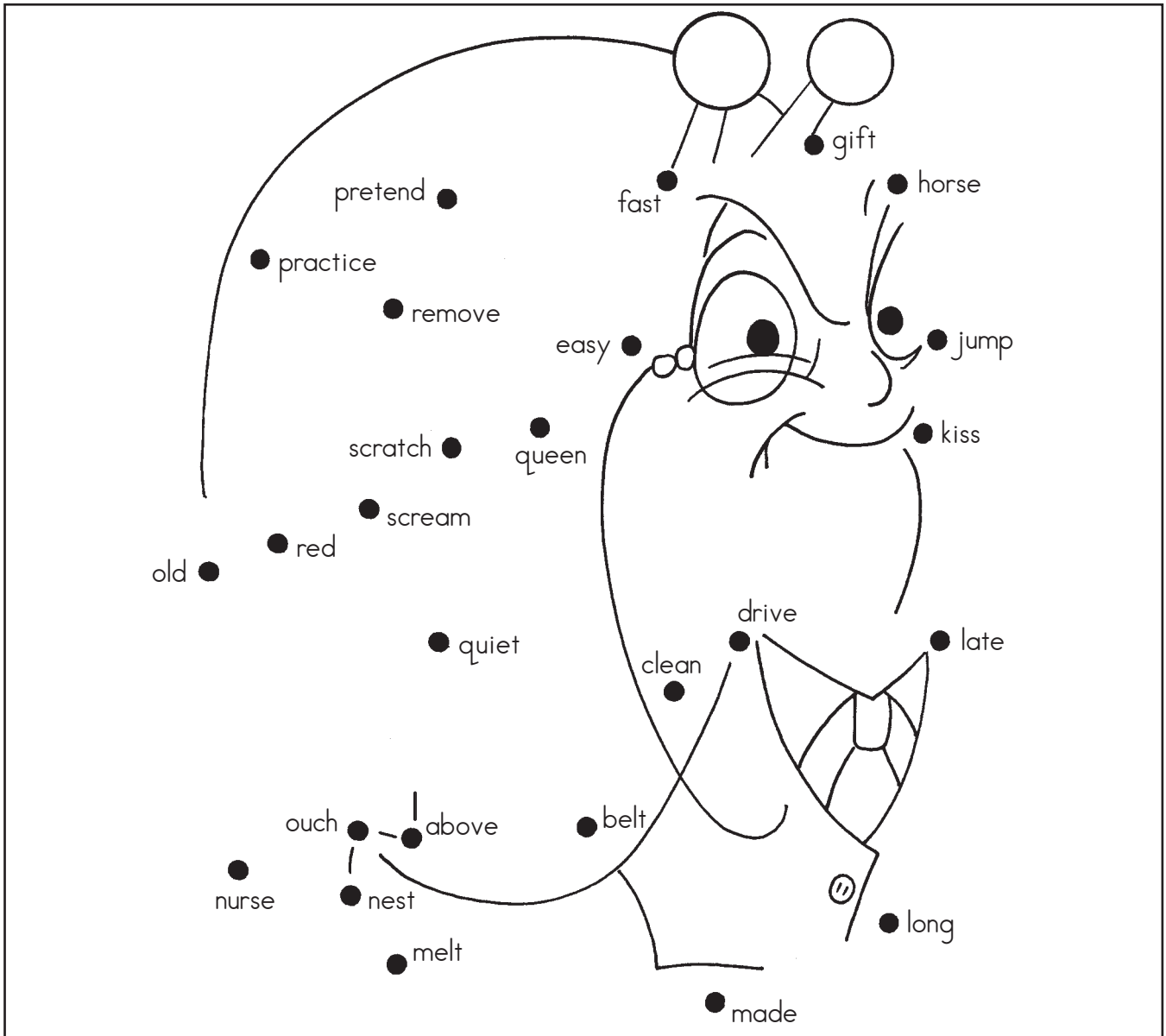
Alphabetizing is organizing words in ABC order.



CJ's ABC Order

Alphabetizing words by the first, second, and third letter

Connect the dots in alphabetical order.



Teaching alphabetizing with objects makes learning this skill fun. Gather paper, a pencil, and various objects from around the house. Make sure you collect some objects that begin with different letters and other objects that begin with the same letter. Tell your child you are going to play an alphabetizing game. Ask him to look at the objects and bring you the object that begins with an A. Together spell and write down the name of the object. Move through the objects and alphabet in this manner. When you come to two objects that begin with the same letter, guide your child to the second letter in the word to be alphabetized, and continue from there.
